

RESOLUTION NO. 17-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLBROOK, ARIZONA, ORDERING AND CALLING A GENERAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 16, 2017, IN AND FOR THE CITY OF HOLBROOK, ARIZONA, TO SUBMIT TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE TOWN THE QUESTION OF THE PROPOSED COLLECTION OF THE PRIMARY (AD VALOREM) PROPERTY TAXES.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Holbrook, Arizona (the "City"), determine that the City should levy primary (ad valorem) property taxes in the next and each succeeding tax year for the purposes permitted by applicable law and set forth in the official ballot; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 42-17056, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended, the Mayor and Council of the City must submit the proposed amount to be raised by primary (as valorem) property taxes for approval of the voters; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 35-453, Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended, the Mayor and Council of the City must order an election to determine whether such indebtedness shall be authorized; and

WHEREAS, for purposes of the foregoing, the Mayor and Council of the City must order the election (hereinafter the "Election") to be held not less than thirty (30) nor more than one hundred fifty (150) days from the date of this Resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLBROOK, ARIZONA:

Section 1. That the Election is hereby ordered and called to be held on May 16, 2017, a day not less than thirty (30), nor more than one hundred fifty (150), days from the date of the adoption of this Resolution, at which time there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the City the proposed amount to be raised by primary (ad valorem) property taxes set forth in the official ballot and for the purposes set forth in the official ballot.

Section 2. That the official ballot for the Election (hereinafter referred to as the "Official Ballot") shall be in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

Section 3. (A) That notice of the Election shall be given by mailing an informational pamphlet (hereinafter referred to as the "Informational Pamphlet") and a sample of the Official Ballot to the residence of each registered voter within the City not less than thirty-five (35) days before the date of the Election.

(B) That the Informational Pamphlet shall be prepared by the Clerk of the City, and the Clerk of the City is hereby authorized and directed to request arguments for and against the property tax, and to cause the Informational Pamphlet to

be provided as and under the circumstances described herein in the form she deems acceptable. The Clerk of the City is hereby authorized and directed to submit, within thirty (30) days after the date of the Election, a copy of the Informational Pamphlet to the Arizona Department of Revenue.


Section 4. (A) That the Clerk of the City is hereby authorized and directed to conduct the Election as a mail ballot election in accordance with the requirements of Arizona Revised Statutes, as amended, Title 16, Chapter 4, Article 8.1. The ballots shall be mailed to each registered voter in the City of Holbrook not more than 33 nor less than 15 days prior to the Election.

(B) That all expenditures as may be necessary to order, notice, hold and administer the Election are hereby authorized, which expenditure shall be paid from current operating funds of the City

(c) That the Clerk of the City is hereby authorized to take all necessary action to facilitate the Election.

Section 3: Navajo County registration and voting lists will be used for the municipal election. In order to be qualified to vote voters must be registered by April __, 2017.
