**A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE HOLBROOK UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT #3  
AND THE CITY OF HOLBROOK, SUPPORTING A STATEWIDE, POSTSECONDARY  
ATTAINMENT GOAL AND A WORLD-CLASS EDUCATION FOR ALL  
STUDENTS**

**RECITALS:**


1. The Holbrook Unified School District ("District") and the City of Holbrook Arizona ("City"), recognize that education must be a top priority in our community to ensure a strong economic future and a higher quality of life.
2. District and City recognize the goal to increase the percentage of three and four year old children in a quality early learning center from twenty-one (21) percent to forty-five (45) percent by 2030.
3. District and City recognize the goal to increase the percentage of 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students who score proficient or highly proficient on the English language arts state assessment to increase from forty-four (44) percent to seventy-two (72) percent by 2030.
4. District and City recognize the goal to increase the percentage of 8th grade students who are prepared to be successful in high school math from thirty-six (36) percent to sixty-nine (69) percent by 2030.
5. District and City recognize the goal to reduce the percentage of sixteen (16) to twenty-four (24) year olds that are not going to school or working from fourteen (14) percent to seven (7) percent by 2030.

6. District and City recognize the goal to increase the percentage of high school students who graduate in four (4) years from eighty (80) percent to ninety (90) percent by 2030.
7. District and City recognize the goal to increase the percentage of high school graduates enrolled in postsecondary education the semester after graduating high school from fifty-three (53) percent to seventy (70) percent by 2030.
8. District and City recognize the need to improve educational attainment across the state and in our community, and support the statewide attainment goal for Arizona residents ages 25-64 who have completed a 2-or-4 year degree or received an industry certificate increase from forty-three percent (43%) to sixty percent (60%) by 2030.
9. District and City recognize the need to improve Arizona's ranking for median elementary teacher pay from fiftieth (50) in the nation to the national median by 2022.

**IT IS RESOLVED** by the Governing Board of the Holbrook Unified School District #3 and the Mayor and City Council of Holbrook, Arizona, as follows:

1. District and City affirm commitment to achieving the statewide attainment goals set forth above and support the use of the Arizona Education Progress Meter as the tool to measure progress toward the attainment goal by tracking the priority indicators for our community.
2. District and City affirm that each are a World Class Education Partner with Expect More Arizona and will work together to advance this shared vision for education.
