Filing guideline for ballot measure argument

Before filing the argument, please make sure:

- The argument is 300 words or less
- The argument is written exactly how the filer wants it to appear in the pamphlet. The argument will be entered into the pamphlet verbatim; no grammatical or textual changes will be made to the document.
- The argument contains the original signature (no faxed signatures) of each person sponsoring it.

Signature/name requirements:

- For arguments filed and paid for by an **individual**, only the signature of the individual is required
- Arguments sponsored by an **organization** or **corporation** (NOT a Political Committee) must be signed by at least TWO executive officers and must be identified by a group
- Arguments sponsored by a **political committee** must be signed by the Committee's Chairman or Treasurer and must be identified by a Committee Name.

All arguments must include the name, address or P.O. Box, city and telephone number of the person(s) signing it. Only the name of the person(s) signing will appear in the publicity pamphlet.

No arguments will be accepted after Monday, March 21, 2019, 5 p.m.

Ballot will contain:

A question to approve the collection of primary property taxes.

A question to amend the Holbrook City Charter
