

CITY OF HOLBROOK RESOLUTION NO. 11-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOLBROOK, ARIZONA, AMENDING THE FEES FOR NEW WATER AND SEWER SERVICE USERS OF THE CITY.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, the City of Holbrook operates the water and sewer systems for Holbrook; and

WHEREAS, the City of Holbrook installs new service for water and sewer users in the City of Holbrook, and

WHEREAS, given increased costs in operation and maintenance it has become necessary to amend the fees for new water and sewer services;

ENACTMENT:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Holbrook, Arizona, as follows:

1. The following fees are hereby to be charged for new water and sewer services:

4" RESIDENTIAL/COMMERCIAL

Initial Tap Charge (up to 20 linear feet)in dirt	\$500.00 Plus Buy-in charge below
Initial Buy-in Charge	\$200.00
Re-Tap charge (up to 20 linear foot)in dirt	\$250.00 No Buy-in charge
Additional charge for tap on paved street (up to 20 linear feet)	\$200.00
Cost for pavement repair (installation is beyond 20 feet) cost per lineal foot	In dirt \$12.50 and pavement add \$10.00 more

6" MULTI-FAMILY/COMMERCIAL

Initial Tap Charge (up to 20 linear feet)	\$750.00 up to 6' in depth more than 6' \$50.00 per foot additional charge Plus Buy in Rates Below
Commercial Buy-in Fee based on fixture units as defined in International Plumbing code	\$20.00 per fixture unit
Re-Tap charge(up to 20 linear foot) in dirt	\$300.00 No Buy-in Charge
