

RESOLUTION 10-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF HOLBROOK, ARIZONA PROTESTING THE STATE OF ARIZONA'S PLAN TO PRIVATIZE REST AREAS

WHEREAS, the City of Holbrook opposes the privatization of any rest areas in or around the City; and

WHEREAS, Federal law prohibits the commercialization of rest areas along interstate highways; and


WHEREAS, a change in this law would threaten existing businesses that depend on sales to interstate travelers. Travel Plazas, truck stops, restaurants, gas stations and convenience stores employ thousands, and;

WHEREAS, the privatization of rest areas would threaten jobs, businesses and the property tax base of local governments;


WHEREAS, rural areas and county governments need sales and property taxes paid by the business located at interstate exits to fund schools, police and fire protection.


